● 7:30 – 9:30 a.m. – Get Ready for the RLA GED Test

This class will teach the augmentative essay so students can complete the writing component for the GED test. Student will take a GED ready test to measure their ability levels and work on improving their reading skills.

● 9:30 – 11:30 a.m. – Get Ready for the RLA GED Test

This class will teach the augmentative essay so students can complete the writing component for the GED test. Student will take a GED ready test to measure their ability levels and work on improving their reading skills.

● 12:00 – 2:00 p.m. – Get Ready for the Social Studies GED Test

This class will teach the different components of the social studies test. We will be using computers to “relive” past history. We will go over court cases and other important historical documents. Students will also work on improving reading, map, graph, table, and chart skills.

● 2:00 – 4:00 p.m. – Get Ready for the Science GED Test

Students will do scientific experiments, so they can learn the scientific method, learn how to balance equations, and other important concepts relating to the science test. Students will also work on improving reading, map, graph, table, and chart skills.

The goal of students in each class is to test high enough (148+) to take the GED test and complete at least 2 tests by the end of summer.
