The **Lee G. Hanchey Award** is a scholarship in the amount of \$1500. It was created in 2009 by the Friends of the Center for the Arts (FCFA) to honor Mrs. Lee Hanchey, Director of the Center for the Arts (CFA) at Henrico High School from 1996 until her retirement in 2009. A recipient of the Teacher of the Year Award in 2004, Mrs. Hanchey taught those around her to strive for excellence in their lives by displaying exemplary character, strong leadership and communication skills, and a positive attitude. She proved that combining hard work and vision would always lead to success. Mrs. Hanchey has devoted her career, as well as her personal time, to furthering arts education and recognition. She strongly believes in the value of higher education and dedication to study. Even upon retirement, Mrs. Hanchey is a regular audience member of the CFA events.

The **William Patrick Gorman Memorial Fund** was established by Patrick's family and friends as a positive and loving way to remember his life and preserve his memory. Patrick was 17 when he died suddenly of a congenital heart defect. Most people were unaware of Patrick's many physical limitations because he had an uncomplaining attitude and beautiful smile. Art was one of Patrick's greatest passions, and he was a gifted artist. In a fitting tribute, his memorial fund supports educational experience for visual arts students at the Center for the Arts.

The Gorman Award is a \$1000 scholarship awarded to a rising junior or senior Visual Arts student to pursue an arts-related course or fund materials for a community-based project.

Important Information for CFA SENIORS!!!

1. SENIOR EXCHANGE DAYS

Please see the information below about the SENIOR EXCHANGE DAYS – you will be able to pick up CFA HONOR STOLEs, CFA Certificates and FCFA Scholarship Awards at the EXCHANGE DAYS as well!!!

To pick-up your CFA HONOR STOLEs and CERTIFICATES during SENIOR EXCHANGE DAYS:

- Seniors MUST show their fulfilled OBLIGATIONS receipt in order to pick-up celebratory items. The “obligations cleared” stop is the student pick-up loop near attendance. Students CLEARED of all obligations will be permitted to proceed to the HHS and CFA celebration pick-up tables.
- **NOTE – Several seniors have outstanding obligations.** You should have received a letter from HHS Administration if you have outstanding obligations. **If you are not sure if you have obligations, please contact us and we will let you know!!**
- There will be a CFA/FCFA TABLE set up at the end of the 11 Building in the Driver’s Ed/ROTC parking lot. Parents and Seniors MUST stay in the car at all times!
 - Seniors MUST show their fulfilled, cleared OBLIGATIONS receipt in order to pick-up CFA/FCFA items. **UPDATE: Payment for outstanding obligations must be with CASH/MONEY ORDER or CREDIT CARD. Obligations MAY NOT be paid by check. Obligations CAN BE paid online with Credit Cards for your convenience.**
 - Seniors (or parents of the senior) may pick up their OWN CFA Honor Stole and Certificate – **you will NOT be permitted to pick-up stoles or certificates or items for any other student.**
 - If you want your HONOR STOLE in time for the Graduation Ceremonies/Portrait, you MUST make plans to come during the scheduled Exchange Days!!

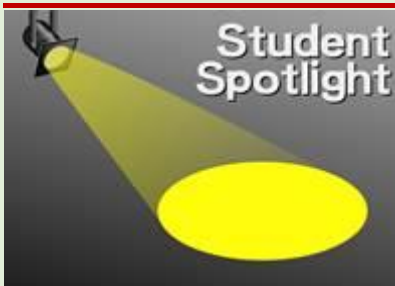
