Thaira Coleman will be attending the University of North Carolina Greensboro in the fall of 2020. Thaira will be majoring in Nursing and minoring in Dance. She was also accepted to George Mason University and was awarded a \$26,000 scholarship to Penn State.

Cameron Harris will be attending Howard University in the fall of 2020, majoring in Dance Arts. Cameron was also accepted to VCU. She was awarded a \$16,000 (\$4,000 per year) scholarship. Cameron was the recipient of the FCFA \$750 Curriculum Area Scholarship for Dance. Cameron plans to become a professional dancer.

Kelsi James will be attending George Mason University in the fall of 2020 as a Psychology major. Kelsi was also accepted to the following universities: Drexel University, Xavier University, Old Dominion University, East Carolina, Bridgewater College, Radford, Dean College, Virginia State University, Longwood, Randolph-Macon College; and she also received \$16,000 scholarship from Radford University. Kelsi plans to become a Clinical Neuropsychologist.

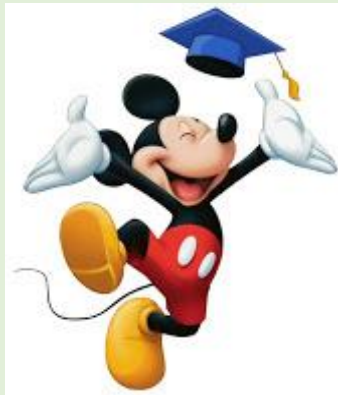
