Happy Thursday! I hope everyone is doing well!

**SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021 – what it will look like??**

We are getting lots of questions about what the 2020-2021 school year will look like. We know this year will look different with an all-virtual start, but we are looking forward to teaching our CFA students – we miss you! Henrico HS will be following our typical bell schedule (attached), so our CFA classes will meet during their regularly scheduled times:

- ALL CFA Level I classes meet during 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> block (12:45-2:15 p.m.)
- ALL CFA Level II classes meet during 1<sup>st</sup> block (9:00-10:00 a.m.)
- All CFA Level III classes meet during 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> block (2:25-3:55 p.m.)\*
- \*Dance Level III will meet during 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> block with Dance Level IV*
- All CFA Level IV classes meet during 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> block (10:10-11:40 a.m.)

We will offer a combination of online and project-based classes, so students might not have to attend online classes every day - some days there might be lectures or demonstrations that students will need to log-in to participate - but other days might be allocated for project-based individual work or practice at home. We will have more details on how the classes will look as we get closer to the start of school - we are planning to hold a CFA Town Hall meeting later in August or early September.

Please know that we want the best for our CFA students and will do our best to give them the highest quality arts education possible during these unusual times. We will do our best to meet all student, parent and teacher needs and will be flexible if we need to try different approaches to make things work!

Our principal, Ms. Castillo-Rose, has been holding Town Hall meetings and sending weekly messages to parents on Sundays. **The next TOWN HALL for HHS parents will be on Monday, August 17 at 5:00 p.m.**

Summer Photo Shoots will be Wednesday, Sept 2th from 9:00 a.m.-3:30 p.m. and Thursday, Sept 3rd from 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Please note that Strawbridge will not be providing the tuxedo or drapes for students for senior pictures at this time because of COVID-19 safety concerns.

During this photo session, seniors will sit for the following **THREE** poses: head and shoulders, indoor casual, outdoor environmental.

To participate in this session, seniors must sit for **ALL** three poses. There will be other opportunities for seniors who just want the yearbook picture.

For the head and shoulders pose, seniors should wear the following:

- a button down white dress shirt with a tie  
or
- a solid black dress or blouse (no spaghetti straps, strapless or low-cut styles, please)

Seniors may also bring at least 1 other casual outfit for the indoor casual and the outdoor environmental poses.

### **Counseling Corner**

#### **GRADES and PARCHMENT**

**PARCHMENT** is for **ALL STUDENTS** to Access Unofficial and Official Transcripts with 19-20 final grades. Due to the school closure resulting in the inability for students to access printed report cards, transcripts for special programs, etc., HCPS is providing access to unofficial and official transcripts through Parchment for all grade levels, typically only available to 12th graders.

First, the Parchment Permission Form is required to receive your unique registration code for Parchment. The Parchment Permission Form is available online through Rycor. **SEE ATTACHED DOCUMENT WITH INSTRUCTIONS.** Parents will need to log in or create a PowerSchool Parent Portal account then select "Access Online Forms" on the left panel and find the form under School Specific Forms. The form should populate with your child's information. A parent should then sign, date, and submit.

Counseling will automatically be notified once your Parchment Permission Form is submitted, but you are welcome to email your counselor as a follow-up.

Once the Parchment Permission Form is received, the student will hear from the school counselor with their unique registration code and information for Parchment. At that time, Parchment will allow the student to create an account (with use of the REQUIRED registration code).

Once the student creates the Parchment account (with the code), the transcript credential can be matched to the learner account and the student may request transcripts when needed.

Please be mindful that this is a new process for all of us and it may take time for form receipt as well as for orders to be processed. Thank you for your patience.

**Note:** Creating a Parchment Account without the unique code will not allow students to get transcripts or grades. If an account is created prior to receiving the permission form and without the unique code, students will have to create another account once the permission form is turned in and once they receive their unique code. Only Parchment tech support can assist in adjusting this problem. Please only create a Parchment account once you receive your unique code.

### **Previous Messages**

#### **Laptop Reimaging**

Reimaging has never been so important! To improve engagement and learning with peers and teachers in the 20/21 school year, Henrico County Public Schools will be activating the cameras on secondary laptops for middle and high school students. To activate the camera, the laptop needs to be serviced at the student's home school. The total time to perform the work is about 5-10 minutes.

**When: Monday through Thursday**

**Time: 8:30 through 12 and 12:30 through 4:30**

Each location will practice safety precautions for COVID-19. Technical support staff will be wearing masks and practicing additional safety precautions. Each person that arrives to have their HCPS laptop serviced are requested to wear a mask and to practice social distancing. Each line will have tape on the floor about 8 feet apart to help with social distancing.

Only one individual (parent, student or guardian) should enter the school to receive service. The only thing that needs to be brought in to complete the work is the laptop to be reconfigured (no charger, no username/password).

The location at the school to go to for the activation of the laptop camera is the ATTENDANCE door entrance. This support at each school to reconfigure secondary student laptop cameras will continue into the month of August up until start of school.
