For the first few weeks, here are some ideas of how you could use me if you are interested in collaborating on an activity:

Get to Know Me (K-5)

The students will fill out a simple questionnaire about themselves, how they learn, what goals they have this year, and etc. We can then turn this into a FlipBook and post it on your blog! Your students' parents will love it!!!

QR Code Lesson (2 - 5)

Have the student voice record their goals for this year and then we can turn them into a QR codes. You will be able to post these QR codes in your classrooms, newsletters, or even each child's agenda/student folder.

Classroom Rules/Expectations Video (K-5)

We will use PhotoBooth to record your kids saying the rules and expectations of your classroom. We will then put these videos into a project called Animoto, which can be posted on your blog. Another resource your parents will LOVE.

How to use the Computers (2-5)

This is a very basic lesson of how to turn the computers on, log into their classrooms, save their work, and give the proper ways to care for your computer.

How to use the iPad (K-1)

This is a very basic lesson of how to turn the iPads on, use certain apps, and give the proper ways to care for your computer.

Wordle Lesson (About Me)

Have the students use an online resource, Wordle, to write words that describe themselves. These final projects can be printed and posted in the classroom or even better, turned into a Flipbook or Animoto project.

Team Building Activity (K-5)

Looking to have less behavior issues this school year? We'll, I can do 3 simple team building activities with your class that can establish the concept of TEAM and FAMILY in your room.
