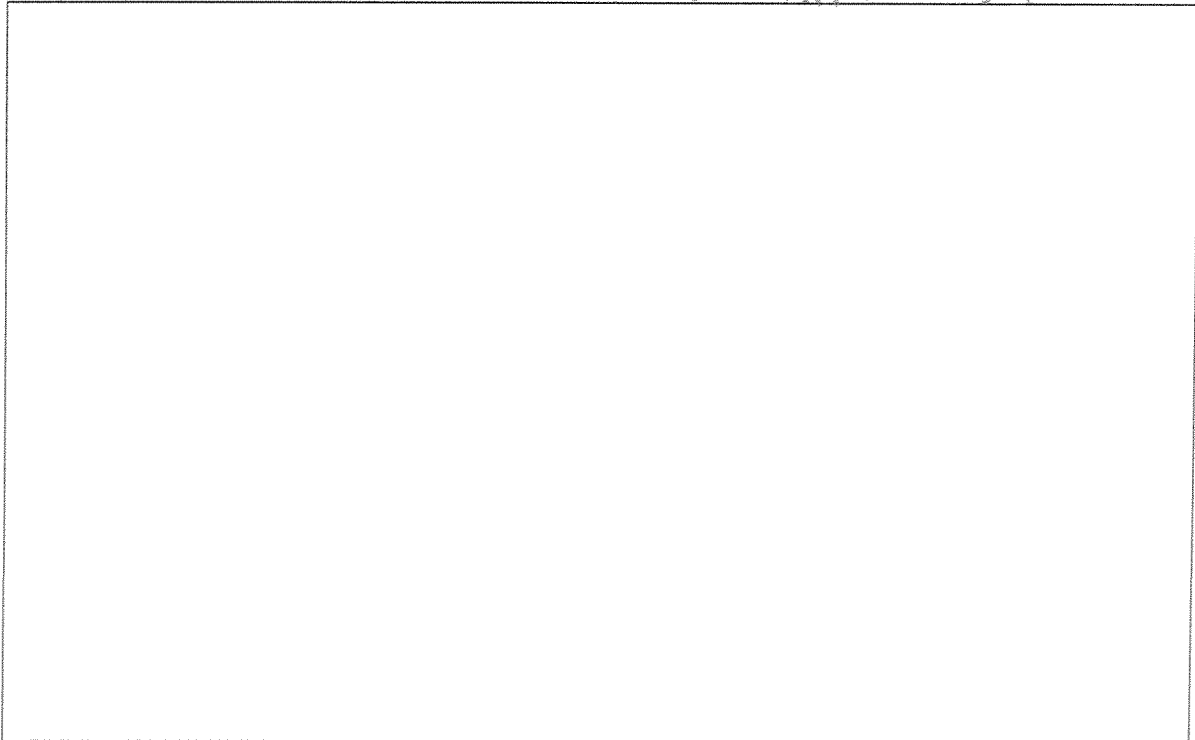

You have been hired as the editor of the Daily Dispatch, Richmond's daily paper. Your job is to put together a Spring 1865, edition of the newspaper. Using a template in Google Docs, you will collaborate with your group to create a newspaper authentic to 1865.

Your newspaper must include the following:

- 1) A heading with the newspaper's name, date, edition
- 2) 4 articles (You pick the topic appropriate to the date. Write 4-5 sentence on each topic.)
- 3) 2 advertisements
- 4) an advice column
- 5) 2 obituaries
- 6) 2 wedding notices
- 7) 2 want ads
- 8) political cartoon (bonus)
- 9) 2-5 photographs from our folder

Use the attached template to design your newspaper.
Decide who will write what. Plan out your layout.
