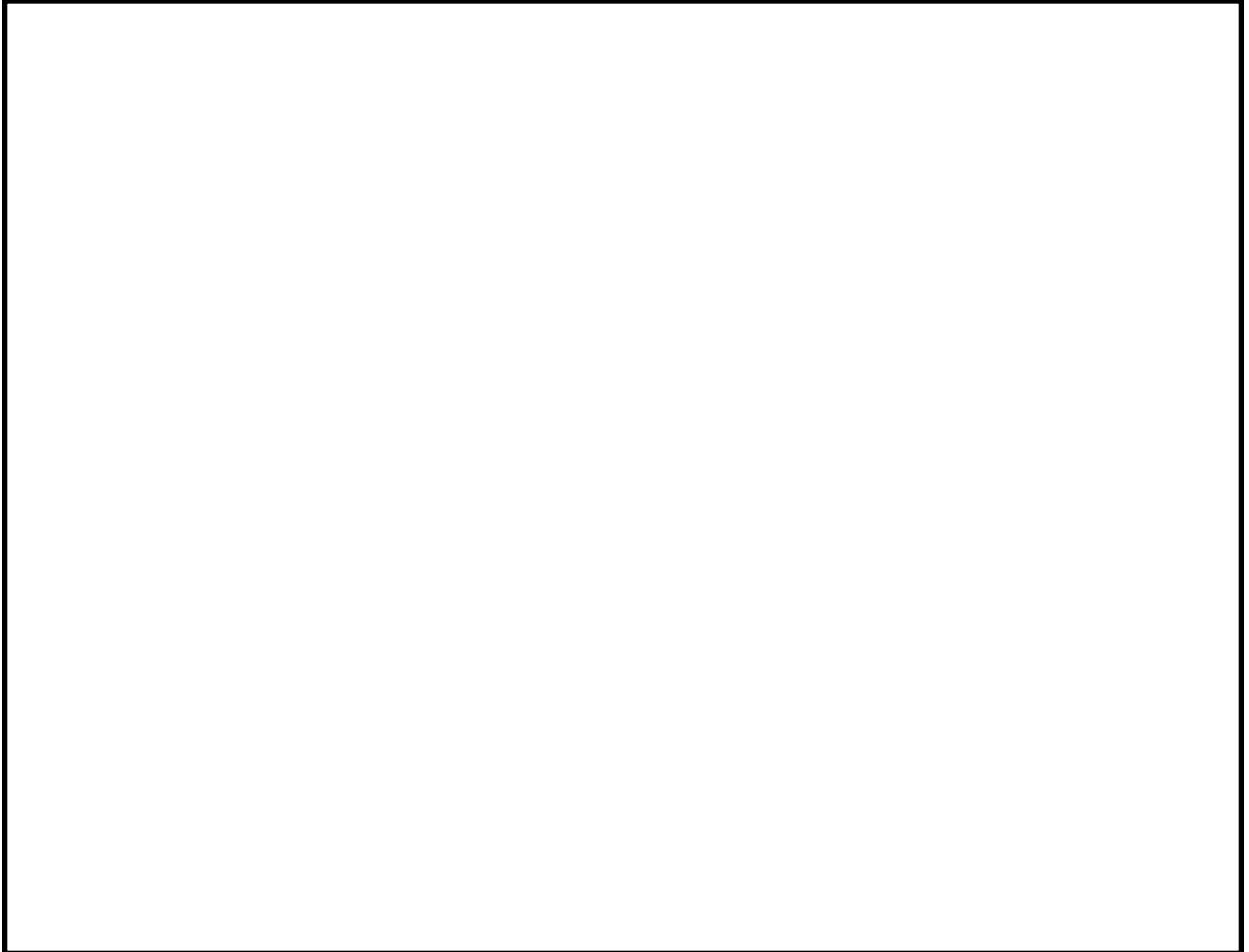

Criteria for building your symbol:

- 1. Your symbol must stand by itself.**

- 4. You may pick two items from our “building supplies” table. (paper towel rolls, water bottles, etc.)**
- 5. You may use as much glue, construction paper, and yarn as you want.**
- 6. You may use markers and crayons on your symbol.**
