Construction Moves Henrico Arts Fall Showcase to CenterStage

Henrico, Va. Nov. 7, 2014 – Renovations at Henrico High School are not quite finished, so the Henrico County Public Schools Center for the Arts has elected to move its Nov. 14-15 Fall Showcase to Richmond CenterStage. The free event features an exhibition of works by visual arts students, followed by a show by performing arts students.

“We are thrilled to give our students the opportunity to perform at CenterStage in honor of the upcoming 25th anniversary of the Center for the Arts,” said Stephanie Poxon, director of the center. “The anniversary is in 2015, but we are starting the celebration early by showcasing our visual arts students in Rhythm Hall and our performing arts students in the Carpenter Theatre.”

The center is also canceling a performing arts dress rehearsal scheduled for Nov. 13. The dress rehearsal performance had been marketed to eighth graders interested in applying to the Center for the Arts. Those students and their guests are now welcome to attend either Fall Showcase event at Richmond CenterStage, a larger venue than the high school auditorium.

The Center for the Arts is one of 12 academic specialty centers based at high schools in Henrico County.
