Use appropriate vocabulary and art terms in all areas to reinforce the knowledge.</p>
Artist Research (pick artist and use mult. Sources to gain the most thorough knowledge possible)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Break down research by content. --organize layout and content in a fluid format --read over organization chart before applying to final page -use time wisely --use teacher feedback to guide layout and content. --use proper vocab when writing research content to make sure correct meaning is implied --know the meaning of the words being used and create vocab list for your artist --take personal voice notes while researching artist 	<p>Utilize peer and teacher feedback to make corrections to work</p> <p>Make sure all writing/research helps you gain knowledge that can be applied later.</p> <p>Don't just state, but translate the content of an artist statement</p> <p>Use personal voice and own words to create understanding</p>
