Science Museum of Virginia Student Volunteer Positions Available



Must be at least 14 years old and able to commit to a consistent, regular schedule - once a week or once every other week - for a minimum of six months.

• Gallery Education Interpreter - Gallery Education volunteers bring passion, skills, and special talents to work closely with Science Museum staff to provide a quality, fun, engaging, inclusive, science experience for guests, encouraging and assisting them as they interact with exhibits and in labs.

Shift times: 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. or 1 p.m. – 5 p.m., on normal operating days.

- **Dome Usher** Help guests blast off in The Dome. Dome Ushers greet, take tickets, answer questions and assist guests as they enter and exit The Dome. They should be comfortable interacting with the public, reliable and able to work independently. Shift times: 10:30 a.m. 3:30 p.m., on normal operating days. May vary with show schedule.
- Forge Maker Challenge Assistant Maker Challenge Assistants help facilitate a variety of open-ended, design/engineering challenges during pre-scheduled Maker Challenge times. Maker Challenges are open to all guests, regardless of age, and allow for larger groups to participate in *The Forge* during this drop-in programming. Shift times: 10 a.m. 12 p.m., on normal operating days.
- Special Events Assistant These volunteers are on-call for special programming, lectures, exhibitions openings and a variety of other special events. They will greet and direct guests, distribute programs and conduct educational activities. Special Event volunteering does not demand a consistent time commitment. Volunteers sign up only for events for which they are available.
