Congressman McEachin is pleased to invite students in Virginia's 4th Congressional District to apply for a nomination to the United States Service Academies:

- United States Air Force Academy www.usafa.af.mil
- United States Merchant Marine Academy www.usmma.edu
- United States Military Academy <u>www.westpoint.edu</u>
- United States Naval Academy <u>www.usna.edu</u>
- United States Coast Guard <u>www.uscg.mil</u>

Each applicant for a nomination must meet the following eligibility requirements as of July 1st of the year of admission to an academy:

- Age: Be at least 17 years old, but not have passed the 23rd birthday
- Citizenship: Must be a U.S. citizen
- Marital Status: Must be unmarried, not pregnant, and without legal obligation to support children or other dependents
- Residence: Must reside within the boundaries of the 4th Congressional District of Virginia.
- Skill / Fitness: Must meet the medical, physical, and academic requirements of the Academy

Application Process:

- The online application for nominations for the Academy Classes of 2022 will be available on April 11, 2017 at www.mceachin.house.gov/services. Deadline for submission of applications and all required materials will be November 10, 2017.
- In addition to the application found online, applicants must also submit their official transcripts, standardized test scores (SAT/ACT), two letters of recommendation, an essay and a current photo.
- Applicants must begin the application process with the academy of their choice as well.
- Congressman McEachin's review committee will evaluate each applicant and provide recommendations to the Representative. Qualified applicants will be interviewed.
- Applicants are evaluated in the areas of academics, standardized test scores, extracurricular activities, athleticism, leadership and community service.
- Applicants chosen to receive an academy nomination must then compete for an appointment from the service academy directly.
