## Adolescent Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)

Individual and family therapy does not always provide the structure and intensity that is often required to help families when a teen is struggling with active substance use. Our Adolescent Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) is for those abusing adolescents who do not require residential treatment.

This program is designed to provide a safe environment for young people to identify risk factors for addiction and begin to repair the damage caused by substance abuse. It is generally recognized that young people have different physical, emotional, mental and spiritual issues than adults. Chemically dependent adolescents face difficult challenges as they enter recovery and can benefit from a safe place to explore those areas with professionals who understand their special concerns.

- Motivational Enhancement Group Therapy
- Relapse Prevention Group Therapy
- Parent/Adolescent Psychoed Group (Fridays)
- Individual & Family Therapy
