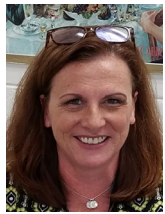




Why We Love the Henrico HS IB Program

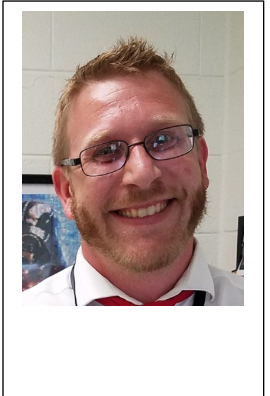
