Henrico High School has been authorized since 1995 by the IBO to offer IBO-validated grades for the Diploma Program.

- To be eligible for an IB Diploma in Grade 12, students must complete at least three higher level (HL) programs and three standard level (SL) programs. Higher Level courses are always a two year program. Standard level courses may be one or two years.
- Course availability is based on student enrollment, requests, and the requirements outlined by IBO. Additional courses such as AP are not guaranteed to be compatible with the IB schedule.
- In addition to the IB required courses, sophomores must complete Service as Action as well as the Personal Project. Diploma students must submit the Extended Essay and meet the goals and outcomes of creativity, activity, and service (CAS) in grades 11 and 12.
- Henrico High School Diploma Program also offers "Course Student Status" to students who decide that pursuing Diploma does not meet their educational goals. They may still sit for exams and earn college credit for completion of courses and exams. Students must take at least two DP classes to remain in the program.
